

Mental Health Services in Gratiot County Jail

Services You Will Receive

Gratiot Integrated Health Network has trained and certified counselors available to help individuals manage their mental health needs including:

- Anxiety- racing thoughts, worry, fear of the unknown,
- Depression- feeling down, lack of motivation, feeling worthless
- Stress- lack of sleep, loss, being away from family
- Hopeless thoughts
- Thoughts of Suicide
- Other mental health concerns

Individual times to talk about personal concerns may be requested.

* Medication requests go through the jail medical staff*


How to Request Services

An individual may request services by asking a deputy to help them contact Mental Health Services.

Services can be paused or stopped at any time. If an individual wants to pause or stop services, they must let a deputy know to be taken off the call list.

Cost to Receive Services

There is no cost to utilize this service while in jail. Services are not billed to insurance.



After Care

If requested, Gratiot Integrated Health Network staff will assist in scheduling a screening for services with your local Mental Health provider.

GIHN staff will also help with referrals to other community resources. (DHHS, housing, etc.)
